Bulletin Extras


A Bulletin Extra is simply sent out to the whole email list, so it does not involve much effort, does it?

Car parking permits

In the past, annual parking permits could be purchased from Richmondshire District Council. These were valid for a few car parks within Richmondshire, including Leyburn and Hawes.

Now that smaller district councils form part of North Yorkshire Council, such permits can be purchased from NYC. This can be done online at:

northyorks.gov.uk/roads-parking-and-travel/parking permits

or by phoning 0300 131 2131.

The cost is £125, which is the same as before, but now your permit will give you the right to park in any council car park throughout Richmondshire. Colin Day
