Emergency

What should you do if you find someone in urgent need of medical help?

If the situation is very bad, dial 999 and ask for 'Medical'. The medic who answers will ask you about the symptoms, such as 'Are they conscious?', 'Are they breathing?' If the condition is very serious, an ambulance will be sent.


While waiting for the ambulance, the medic will still want to talk to you over the phone. They may give first aid advice. They may tell you to get the defibrillator from the Institute (now working again) for which they will give you the code to unlock it.

You will now see how vital it is for you to have someone else helping you. The medic wants you still to be in touch, so your helper must get the defibrillator. You cannot phone anyone else.

The medic will then tell you how to use the defibrillator. When the ambulance arrives, you can ring off and leave everything to them. They do a wonderful job!
