An Evensong service will be held in the Mission Room on **Sunday 23rd November** at 3pm. All welcome.

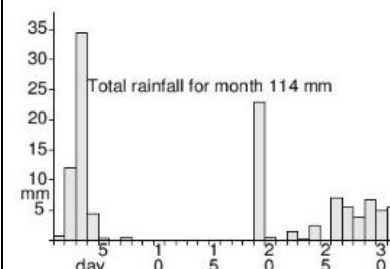
